We collected questioning data in 28 of 30 classrooms observed. We collected data on Single-Response Questions, Open-Ended "Fishing" Questions, and Engagement Questions. The results were as follows:

Single Response- 34%

Open-Ended- 50%

Engagement- 16%

NEXT STEPS: What are the actions needed before next coaching meeting?

- Teachers will create a 15-Day Challenge unit of study.
- Teachers will record themselves and scribe their own Questioning Response for data.
- Administrative Team will conduct an additional focus walk on questioning on all teachers in order to increase student engagement in the classroom.
