Team Discussions Teachers are continuing to modify their instruction on a 35 day plan which is designed to help them focus on essential standards and how each of them can support other content areas by collaboratively planning. Examples included using similar vocabulary, inter disciplinary projects, common instructional engagement strategies, etc. 8th Grade We met(observed) Mrs. J-Walker regarding data analysis for grade level support for 8 th grade teachers and their the 35 day plan according to CFAs and the instructional implications as we move closer to the GA Milestones test. Teachers are working in content area teams to deliver and analyze CFA data and looking for commonalities and how to effectively use flexible grouping. All of the 8 th grade teachers are delivering CFA and coming ready to determine next steps. 7th Grade Teachers are determining how the content areas can work more effectively together to generalize student skills in to all areas. Most of the teachers are coming prepared with CFA data, however not all are consistently prepared. One area of need was identified as students needing support with citing contextual evidence when taking	Leadership/Guiding Coalition Discussion Meet with Leadership Team to review and modify CIP for SY 17-18 and determined action steps as we move into planning for school improvement according to recent progress monitoring data. Each of the six areas of the CIP where reviewed and goals were modified as we looked at the last progress monitoring data (AIMSWeb), Milestone data from last year, and CFA data in SchoolCity. This collaborative meeting will be the first draft of the CIP and will be reviewed with staff over the next few weeks.

Identified concerns included that not all teachers are effectively using the data for flexible grouping with fidelity. The need for teachers to use this information for remediation and extension activities was also noted.</p>
