REFLECTION: What did I learn? Based on what I learned, what will have the greatest impact on student learning?

Based on today's support I learned that we need to continue to look at targeted data points to drive our instructional practices. I will continue to work with the leadership team to determine how we can work collaborative to support teachers with increasing the level of rigor, increase the pace in classroom instruction, and determine how to more effectively differentiate instruction for learning.

Ms. Cano suggestions of how to make relevant real life connections to learning, what we are going to do for those students that have master the standards, and increasing collaborative practices were helpful. I will work to continue making those critical questions within our PLC work. I will also explore peer tutoring, after school tutoring, and Saturday school as options for students not meeting the expectations.

NEXT STEPS: What are the actions needed before next coaching meeting?

The following actions will be taken before the next coaching meeting:

- Continue to deconstruct standards as a team
- Prioritize Standards for each content area
- Develop a 35 day calendar to teach power standards before the Milestones Test
- Create common assessments that will be used at checkup points throughout the 35 day period and then at the end
- Meet with Mrs. J-Walker to support the instructional coaching model
