 last school year. Daily requirements for what to have completed and brought to the collaborative
 planning session, what work is to be done during that time were developed, and what products
 must be completed in order to have Wednesday as a personal plan.
- Revisiting the math support classes to determine what curriculum is being taught.
- The artifacts that were produced in the PLC collaborative planning process were not used in collaborative planning this visit. These artifacts would be a revamp instead of a redo and allow for a deeper dig.
