Coach Power met with Principal Watkins and Assistant Principal Wright to develop a timeline for six weeks. The administrative team is deeply interested in the ensuring that the collaborative teams understand the urgency of the collaborative process.

It was decided that the teams would begin right away by developing proficiency maps. Coach Power provided a template and sample documents. The teams will then plan a unit to begin in October. This will include the prioritized standards, scoring guides, common assessment plans and how data will be used to inform instruction and intervention next steps.

Coach Power created a time line (see attached) with the team and this will begin the 30/60/90 day

goal setting process. The 30/60/90 SMART goals have only been lightly started and will be the focus of the visit on October 20.

Coach Power provided other resources to the team included Power Point slides that can be used to support implementation and to build common understanding by all teachers of the work needed. Several DOK documents were sent as well as samples of unit plans and maps.

During the visit, I learned that we would have to do a school-wide reset with re-implementing the PLC cycle. During our discussion, the decision was made to begin with 3-5 before working with K-2. In addition, we talked about the importance of systemizing our approach. For example, we needed to develop a teacher friendly lesson planning sheet, instructional calendar, etc.
