REFLECTION: What did I learn? Based on what I learned, what will have the greatest impact on student learning?

We are going to continue our work described below.

What I learned was that we have multiple practices in place such as instructional framework, engagement strategies, learning assessment cycle, higher order thinking questions, differentiation etc. The challenge is that we have learned about the strategies but we are not implementing them well. There is clearly a knowing-doing gap. The greatest impact on student learning is for the teachers to increase their efficacy in a few areas and do them well. We have decided to implement a school wide focus on the same engagement strategies (Turn and talk and response cards) and completing the learning cycle (including common formative assessment.)

2/7/18 Next Steps are to follow up and monitor learning cycle for the next unit of Study (approximately 3 weeks) for ELA and Math (departmentalized teachers). Steps include1) Planning 1 Unit of Study for 10-15 day unit, 2) Create 4 common assessments with 5 questions each 3) plan when those assessments will be given and when the data will be analyzed by grade level 4) Plan Effective instruction keeping in mind Question 3 & 4 (Effective Instructional strategies, What do we do when they do get? And What do they do when they don't get it?

By next coaching meeting each grade level team will complete the learning cycle described above with emphasis on a) change in teacher practice b) change in student learning
