## **REFLECTION:** What did I learn? Based on what I learned, what will have the greatest impact on student learning?

- Design team needed to understand the true meaning of what RTI was and how to effectively implement each tier
- The importance of how the school improvement plan aligned with the PLC process and each Big Rock is aligned with the district's plan along with action items for the principal, teachers and scholars to move the school forward
- Teachers will create a data board to have in their classroom for scholars to see their progress on standards during units
- Teachers will have a better understanding of the cycle 1 protocol with including the 9
  +1 and will help make lesson planning more strategic and aligned with the lesson plan components from the district
- Administrators must be a part of the collaborative team process to help hold everyone accountable and provide the necessary resources for teachers as needed during the collaborative planning time
- There must be a structure created to how often the student data notebooks should be monitored and the data notebooks will be done electronically by all grade levels
- Being able to identify the essential standards and moving this work forward to help with the RTI process is essential for next school year
- Creating an effective RTI model based on fresh data
- Moving the PLC process into the classroom, using the cycle protocol
